Gentlemen:

This is to advise you of our intention to plug the above referenced well. The following is our proposed procedure:

B. Record of All Perforations and/or Open Hole (Any perforations which have previously been cemented off or plugged off should be so noted.)

Perforations 10,896-11,052, CIBP @ 9303 w/25' of cement, perforations 8,990-9,034, perforations 8466-8526 cement squeezed, CIBP at 6050'.


