Kewanee Oil Company plans within the next few days to make application with the Railroad Commission of Texas to dispose of salt water by injecting into a formation productive of oil and gas. The well proposed for injection is presently plugged and abandoned and is located 1667' FNL and 1667' FWL of Section 9, Block 2, University Lands Survey, Andrews County, Texas.
